Kits

The Pro-Strain system comes in kits and multi-packs. When buying in kits, select a straining post kit and 1 or 2 strut kits to complement that, depending if the strainer is installed as an end, two-way or corner post.

Each kit contains the components and fixings required for that element of the system. Strainers come in 3 lengths to accommodate livestock, cattle, rail and deer fences. There are also optional components to suit specific installations e.g. extra-large breast plates when installing in softer ground.

Multi-packs

Multi-packs are ideal for larger projects, providing the individual components in packs which are economic and easier to handle and transport.
